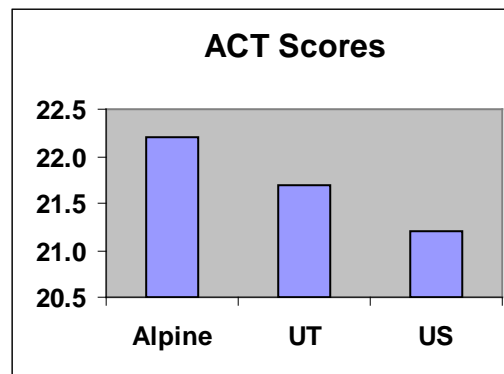

66% of students entering UVU are not prepared for college-level math.

32% of our high school students are not able to pass the state proficiency test in science.
